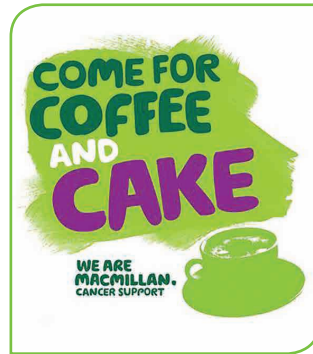


Home Safari

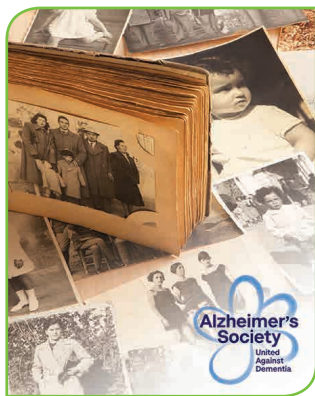
Coffee morning
